Policy and objectives

Quality

- We continuously develop our products and services so that our clients know they can continue to build with and on us in the future.
- We work with project plans to manage our processes.
- We manage our risks and seize our opportunities, ensuring that we remain in control.
- · We make clear agreements and honour them.
- We work in accordance with our management system, certified under the following standards: ISO 9001, ISO 14001, ISO 45001, SCC (VCA)**, Safety Culture Ladder level 4, CS-OOO (Sub-area A: Detection of explosive remnants of war and Sub-area B: Civil engineering support), and the CO₂ Performance Ladder level 5.
- We work in accordance with the BRL SIKB 7000 process certificate and can supply products under the BRL 9313 product certificate.
- We are committed to continuous improvement of our methods and ask our clients for feedback on our performance. We derive improvement points from their feedback.
- We carry out internal and external audits to drive continuous improvement.

Safety

- We demonstrate good employment practices and provide a safe and healthy working environment.
- Our working methods are based on risk assessment and evaluation. This minimises the likelihood of (near) accidents, incidents and damage to equipment, resources and the environment.
- We investigate incidents to gain more insight into their causes, to improve and to prevent recurrence.
- Our self-developed safety programme MvO Safe and the MvO Kompas (MvO Compass) ensure that our employees' safety awareness is continuously reinforced through kick-offs, toolbox meetings, HSE meetings and training sessions.
- We regularly carry out workplace inspections and safety walks to guarantee and improve safety on our construction sites and workplaces.
- We follow the occupational hygiene strategy. In addition, we apply a generous PPE policy so that our people are always protected against daily safety and health risks.

Socially responsible employment

- We want our people to experience that they can rely on Martens en Van Oord as an employer and on one another.
- We consider it important that our people know each other well, feel part of and at home with Martens en Van Oord.
- We apply an MvO Code of Conduct, which describes our corporate culture and the standards and rules we uphold.
